Exact/app. start and ending of the terms  - When do you expect the students to arrive at the latest?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- October 21, 2002 – February 7, 2003: Winter term</li> <li>- March 17 – June 27, 2003: Summer term</li> </ul> <p>If possible a few days before the courses start so that they can settle in, otherwise at least for the courses starting day.</p>
Examination period	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- March 3 – 20, 2003 :</li> <li>- June 13 – July 3, 2003:</li> <li>- September 29 – October 16 2003 (for this session, the participation of Erasmus students is only allowed with the agreement of the home university)</li> </ul>
Introduction programme and period	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- During the intensive French course, several information sessions (administrative and academic information) are organised. Besides, the course itself includes several visits and meetings introducing the students to the city and the University</li> <li>- At the beginning of the academic year the information sessions are repeated for all the students who didn't attend the intensive French course.</li> <li>- At the beginning of the Summer term, the information sessions are repeated for the new incoming students.</li> </ul>
