<b>Health Insurance:</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>SOCIAL SECURITY AND ILLNESS</b></p> <p>European Community countries have agreements with the Spanish Social Security, which covers the medical assistance. For their temporary stay in Spain, students must get the E-111 or E-128 Form from the Social Security before leaving their countries.</p> <p>It is <b>essential</b> that foreign students bring medical insurance from their own country. Students, who don't have Social Security in their own country, have to go to the International Relations Service on their arrival, to prove that they have a private medical insurance. A private insurance can be also obtained in Valladolid. It costs approximately 39 Euros/month.</p> <p>In case of illness, students who are insured by the E.U. (and countries with Medical Assistance agreements with Spain) can go directly to the Social Security Centre nearest to their place of residence.</p>

	<p>We enclose a list of all the Medical Centres of Valladolid, Palencia, Segovia and Soria. If the student goes to another province, this information will be provided by the “Dirección Provincial del INSALUD” of that province.</p> <p>To make use of the medical services, the student must be able to show at the Medical Centre a form or certificate stating that he/she has the right to receive Medical Assistance in Spain, together with a copy and documentation to prove his identity. The original document will be returned to the student and the Centre will keep the copy.</p>
<p><b>Terms:</b></p>	<p>The academic year of the University of Valladolid begins October 1<sup>st</sup> and finishes June 30<sup>th</sup> of the following year. Lectures continue up to the first week of June. <p><b>Registration:</b></p>	<p>All the Erasmus-Socrates students must fill the Foreign Students Register Form, which is available at <a href="http://www.relint.es/estudiantesExtranjeros/inicioIngles.htm">www.relint.es/estudiantesExtranjeros/inicioIngles.htm</a> before 30<sup>th</sup> June. Once sent, it must be printed and mailed with two passport-size photographs to the International Relations Office.</p> <p>All students who arrive in Valladolid must go to the International Relations Service at the Casa del Estudiante 3<sup>rd</sup> floor, Real de Burgos s/n, 47011 Valladolid.</p> <p><u>Students of a European programme and students of bilateral agreements:</u> They have to inform the International Relations Service about the date of their arrival in advance. They also have to go to the International Relations Service as soon as they arrive. Students obtain their acceptance automatically and the procedures are very simple.</p>

<p><b>Language courses:</b></p>	<p>The University of Valladolid organises the following Spanish Language Courses:</p> <p><b>1 SEPTEMBER COURSE (40 hours)</b></p> <p>From September 2nd to September 27<sup>th</sup> 2002.  2 hours a day  Fees: 167.23 Euros  Levels: Initial, intermediate and advanced</p> <p><b>2 OCTOBER-DECEMBER COURSE (45 hours)</b></p> <p>From October 14<sup>h</sup> to December 13<sup>th</sup>, 2002.  5 hours a week  Fees: 198.78 Euros  Levels: Initial, intermediate and advanced</p> <p><b>3 FEBRUARY-MAY COURSE (45 hours)</b></p> <p>From February 17<sup>th</sup> to May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2003  4 hours a week  Fees: 198.78 Euros  Levels: Initial, intermediate and advanced</p> <p>To participate in these courses you need to fill in the application form (see online foreign student guide).</p> <p>Provided that we receive SOCRATES financial aid for this purpose one of these courses will be free for students of Universities which also offer free courses to our students. <b>All the students shall pay 18.93 Euros in concept of administration and material costs.</b></p>

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<p><b>Accommodation and costs:</b></p>	<p>Students wishing to find their own accommodation and participate in the <b>Welcome Week</b> organised by the International Relations Service will receive information about offers of rooms in shared flats. Also, throughout the <b>Welcome Week</b> other students will help to find accommodation.</p> <p><b>PERMANENT ACCOMMODATION IN VALLADOLID</b></p> <p>Different options of accommodation are offered:</p> <p>a) <u>Individual room in a students flat, sharing kitchen, living room and bathroom.</u> The approximate cost for a room is 150 Euros a month. Students usually have to pay a one month deposit.</p> <p>b) <u>“Alfonso VIII” University Residence:</u> limited number of single rooms with bathroom. A single room will cost approximately 240 Euros per person a month. The payment will be made monthly. This Residence has no cooking facilities. However, it has a canteen and a cafeteria.</p> <p><b>It is only possible to rent a room here if you are staying for the entire academic year (October-June).</b></p> <p>c) <u>Accommodation with a Spanish family:</u> including an individual room and all meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) will approximately cost 400 Euros a month.</p>
